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### **Sheringham Seaside Gin – Shirley, BC**

A seaside stroll in a glass! Floral and slightly saline, with hand harvested winged kelp as one of the unique local botanicals

### **Long Table Cucumber Gin – Vancouver, BC**

Bright, refreshing, and slightly vegetal, using bell peppers and Sunshine Coast cucumbers

### **Montis Alpenglow Gin – Whistler, BC**

Distilled in copper pots using the local glacier water from Rainbow Mountain, this spirit is inspired by the grapefruit coloured sunsets

## INTERNATIONAL OFFERINGS

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### **Botanist Gin – Islay, UK**

22 unique Islay botanicals including wood sage and mugwort create a subtle yet complex ultra-smooth gin

### **Gin Mare – Barcelona, Spain**

Distilled from rosemary, thyme, basil, and olives, this expression of the Mediterranean has incredible mouthfeel

### **Brockman's Gin – London, UK**

Intensely smooth, with deep blueberry and blackberry notes to complement the citrus and juniper

*"All gin uses juniper as its main ingredient.  
After that, however, there are very few limitations  
to the hundreds of ingredients a distillery can use.  
Some gins have as few as three or four botanical flavours,  
while the Scottish gin The Botanist has over 22!  
The flavours in gin range from cucumber and rose to  
lavender to lemongrass and black pepper.  
No two gins are alike."*
